## **Hudson-Ellis Scholarship Application**

The Hudson-Ellis Scholarship was established the late Lottie Ellis of Boyle County to provide scholarships to deserving students from Boyle County. This need-based scholarship provides each recipient a renewable award of at least \$1,500.

- Student must be a resident of Boyle County
- Student must be a graduating senior from Boyle County High School, Danville High School, of the Kentucky School for the Deaf
- Student must plan to attend an accredited, degree-granting college or technical school in **Kentucky or Gallaudet University** in Washington, D.C.
- Student must have a cumulative minimum GPA of 3.0
- Student must demonstrate involvement in extracurricular activities and community service
- Student must demonstrate financial need
- Student must qualify for a Federal Pell Grant (or demonstrate equivalent level of need, if student is ineligible to receive Federal Aid)
- Award is renewable for up to four years of undergraduate study provided that the student maintains full-time status and a cumulative minimum GPA of 2.5
